Project Status Update – Phase 1B

This is a construction update for the road and drainage improvements in the Pleasant Valley area. With the curb and sidewalk in place the contractor has been preparing the subsurface for asphalt pavement.

The Contractor intends to begin paving Williwa, Northwind, and a portion of Skipper on Saturday and Sunday (October 10th & 11th). Leading up to paving this weekend, the Contractor will be placing and compacting a thinner layer of Recycled Asphalt Pavement (RAP) over the roadway. Residents can expect to see many trucks and paving crew over the next few days. Paving driveways is expected to occur later next week.

During paving operations (approximately 8AM – 5PM) access to your driveways will be cutoff. Please park your vehicles or on adjacent streets if you need your vehicle during the day. We will try to place road closure signs and barriers as reminders. Also, please do not park on corners of roadways. Keeping the corners clear of vehicles greatly helps when maneuvering our large trucks within neighborhood and is safety concern (fire trucks and other emergency vehicles)!
